Postgraduate Certificate Supervision of Midwives

Fully funded places for NHS Employees

This programme is fully funded for NHS employees working in the area covered by Yorkshire and the Humber Strategic Health Authority, however places are limited and we advise booking well in advance. Please discuss any proposed study with your line manager as soon as possible, as they maintain an interest in your educational and professional development.

Deadline is 29 June.

Who is the programme for?

The Postgraduate Certificate in Supervision of Midwives is a part-time professionally focused programme of study for suitably qualified midwives.

The programme is designed for qualified midwives who are graduates of midwifery, normally with a 2:1 classification.

Non standard entry

Consideration will be given to non-graduate midwives who have the potential to succeed and who can supply appropriate evidence of prior learning. In accordance with established School of Healthcare procedures if you are seeking non-standard entry or the accreditation of prior certificated learning these will be considered by the Individualised Programmes Panel.

Course Content

For the Postgraduate Certificate in Supervision of Midwives you will be required to undertake the following compulsory module: HECS 5153M Preparation of Supervisors for Midwives (45 credits)

In addition you will be required to undertake one 15 credit module, such as : IOFN 5004M Research Methods; HECS 5008M Accredited Learning from Study Days; HECS 5005M Gender and Health; IOFN 5003M Leadership in Healthcare; HECS 5160M Innovation in Health and Social Care; all subject to availability and with agreement with the programme manager.

Student Support

Every student will have access to a named personal tutor for the whole of the programme. The tutor will have the overview of the student's performance and welfare and is the personal contact for that student if there are any problems which may affect individual academic performance.

Submission of applications

Nomination and selection of candidate will be in accordance with the Local Supervisory Authority guidelines which outlines open and transparent local processes for nominations, local preparation of nominees to ensure they understand the role and responsibilities of the supervisor, a closed ballot system verifying some of the key pre-requisite personal attributes of prospective supervisors of midwives and the LSA selection process.

Fees

For non-NHS staff the fees for this certificate are £3,333.
